

OUT OF DISTRICT
Permission to Attend Flinthills USD#492
CONTRACT

All out of district students approved for attendance shall be required to maintain good standing as described on the Request for Nonresident Enrollment Form and summarized below.

Guidelines for Out of District Attendance:

Students must be in good standing with the district’s behavioral expectations.

Students must be in good standing with the district’s attendance policy.

Students must be in good standing with the district’s academic expectations.

Students shall not act in a way that is disruptive or detrimental to other students.

All out of district students will be encouraged to participate in extra-curricular activities. This requires the student to be eligible to participate in KSHSAA activities and meet all residential and academic requirements.

USD#492 has the right to terminate this contract at any time the out of district student fails to meet these guidelines.

Once out of district approval is granted it will remain in force until such time as the student would lose their good standing or choose to leave the district. If a student chooses to leave the district and attend somewhere else, they will have to submit a new Request for Nonresident Enrollment Form.

The principal has the authority to use discretion in individual cases that involve special circumstances such as injury, illness, custody, etc.
