Flinthills USD 492 is located in the Flint Hills of Kansas, covering approximately 400 square miles and includes the rural towns of Cassoday and Rosalia. The district is a progressive 1A school with a total enrollment of 273 students. Flinthills Primary School (PreK-2) is located in Cassoday, while Flinthills Intermediate (3-5), Flinthills Middle (6-8), and Flinthills High School (9-12) are located in Rosalia. The district offers a virtual program. Over 30% of the students attending are out-of-district students.

All Flinthills facilities have been newly renovated since the 2020 bond. The district has two full competition-quality gyms and a practice gym, in Rosalia as well as a fourth small elementary gym at the Primary. The technology used in the district includes a 1:1 initiative, iPads in grades PreK-5 and Chromebooks in grades 2-12. Classrooms are equipped with projectors, SmartBoards, and Promethean Boards.

Extracurricular activities include football, volleyball, cheerleading, wrestling, basketball, baseball, softball, and track. Non-athletic activities include TriM, math relays, Honor Flight, drama, forensics, theater, scholars bowl, student council, band, vocal, FFA, SAFE, and TSA.
